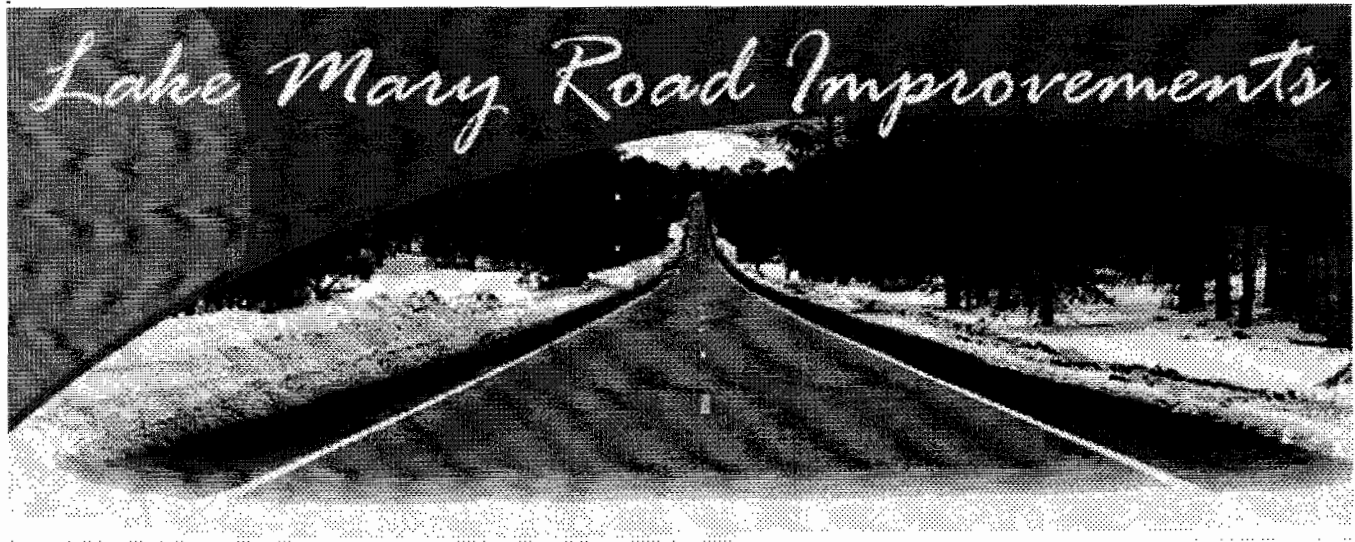

Thanks to all who attended the Open House meeting at the Coconino Community College on Wednesday night. The project team enjoyed meeting everyone and appreciates your support and understanding as we improve the roadway.

### **CLEARING OPERATIONS REQUIRE SHOULDER CLOSURES**

Clearing operations adjacent to Lake Mary Road are the first step to widening the roadway. This work will begin at JW Powell Boulevard and move south along Lake Mary Road. Please be aware of the following impacts:

- **Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009** □ **6 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Motorists are advised to be aware of narrow lanes, reduced speeds, and flagging operations associated with shoulder closures.

**GUARDRAIL WORK AT LAKE MARY BEGINS**

Guardrail removal and replacement will begin along Lake Mary Road adjacent to Lake Mary. Please be aware of the following impacts:

- **Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009** □ **6 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Lanes may be restricted along Lake Mary Road at Lower Lake Mary. Motorists should be aware of narrow lanes, reduced speeds, and possible delays associated with this work. Please remain alert for bicycle traffic traveling through traffic control zones.

**BICYCLE ACCESS POLICY UPDATE**

The Lake Mary Road Improvement Project team is working to accommodate recreational bicycle use of Lake Mary Road during construction. To accomplish this, the Bicycle Access Policy will close Lake Mary Road to bicycle traffic between JW Powell Boulevard and the Flagstaff City Limits Monday through Friday. During this time, cyclists should park beyond the City Limits and avoid riding through the heavy construction zone. Currently, weekend bicycle use of Lake Mary Road is permitted. This Bicycle Access Policy is subject to change as the project moves forward. You will be notified of any change to the Bicycle Access Policy by eNews.

The project team is committed to the safety of the public during construction and would like to remind the community to drive slowly and safely through the construction zone.
