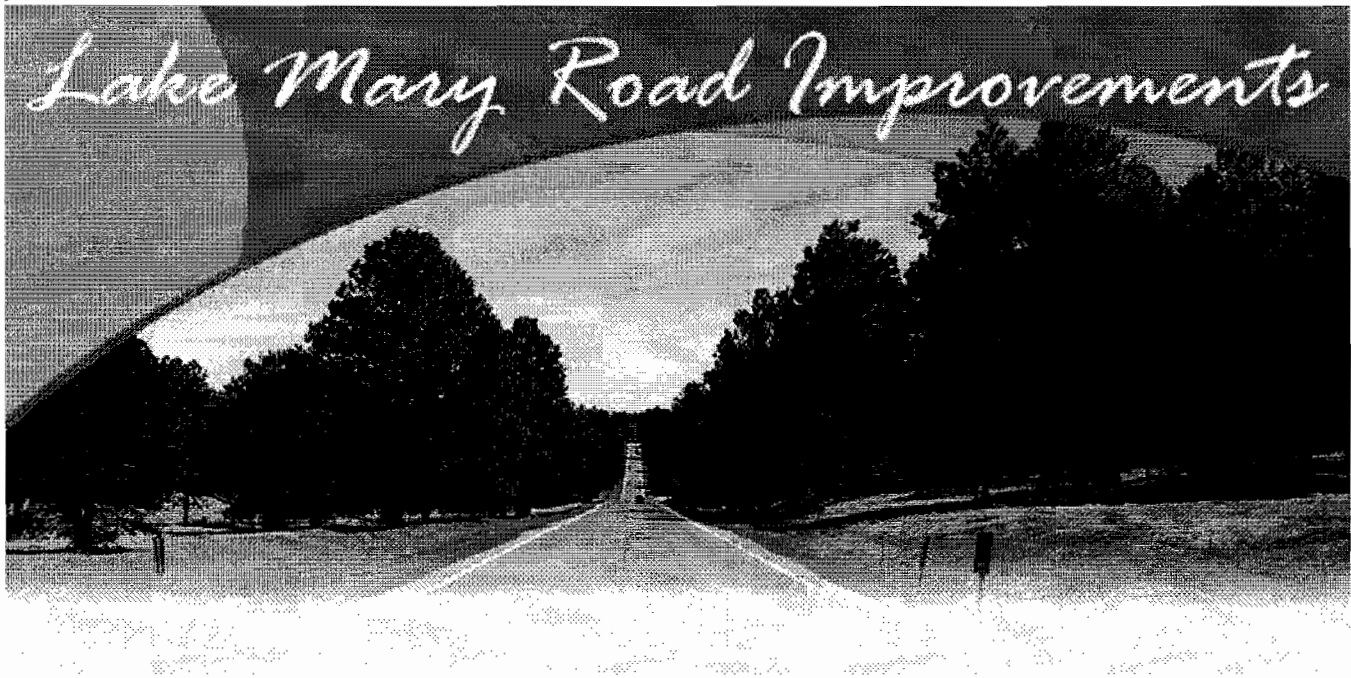

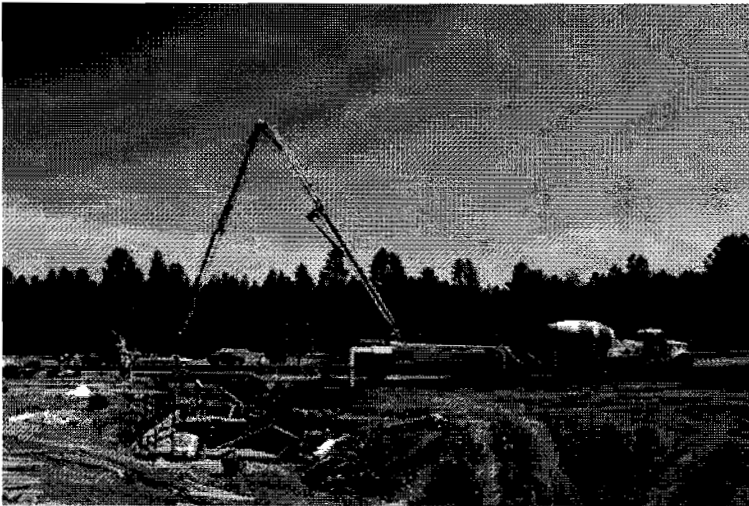

### **ROADWAY WIDENING CONTINUES**

Work on the widened roadway is occurring in cleared areas adjacent to Lake Mary Road, and on paved areas of the road. This work includes new excavation for utility lines, new curb and gutter, and culvert installation. Please be aware of the following impacts:

- **Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> through Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> - 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.**  
Motorists will experience reduced speeds, narrow lanes, and flagging operations as roadway widening is performed. Delays are expected. Please use caution while driving through the work zone.

## **GUARDRAIL WORK AT LAKE MARY NEARS COMPLETION**

Guardrail removal and replacement continues along Lake Mary Road adjacent to Lake Mary. This work is schedule to be complete by the week of May 11, 2009. Please be aware of the following impacts:

- **Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> through Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> - 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

Lanes may be restricted along Lake Mary Road at Lower Lake Mary. Motorists should be aware of narrow lanes, reduced speeds, and possible delays associated with this work. Please remain alert for bicycle traffic traveling through traffic control zones.

## **BICYCLE ACCESS POLICY**

The Lake Mary Road Improvement Project team is working to accommodate recreational bicycle use of Lake Mary Road during construction. To accomplish this, the Bicycle Access Policy will close Lake Mary Road to bicycle traffic between JW Powell Boulevard and the Flagstaff City Limits Monday through Friday. During this time, cyclists are encouraged to park beyond the City Limits and avoid riding through the heavy construction zone. Currently, weekend bicycle use of Lake Mary Road is permitted. 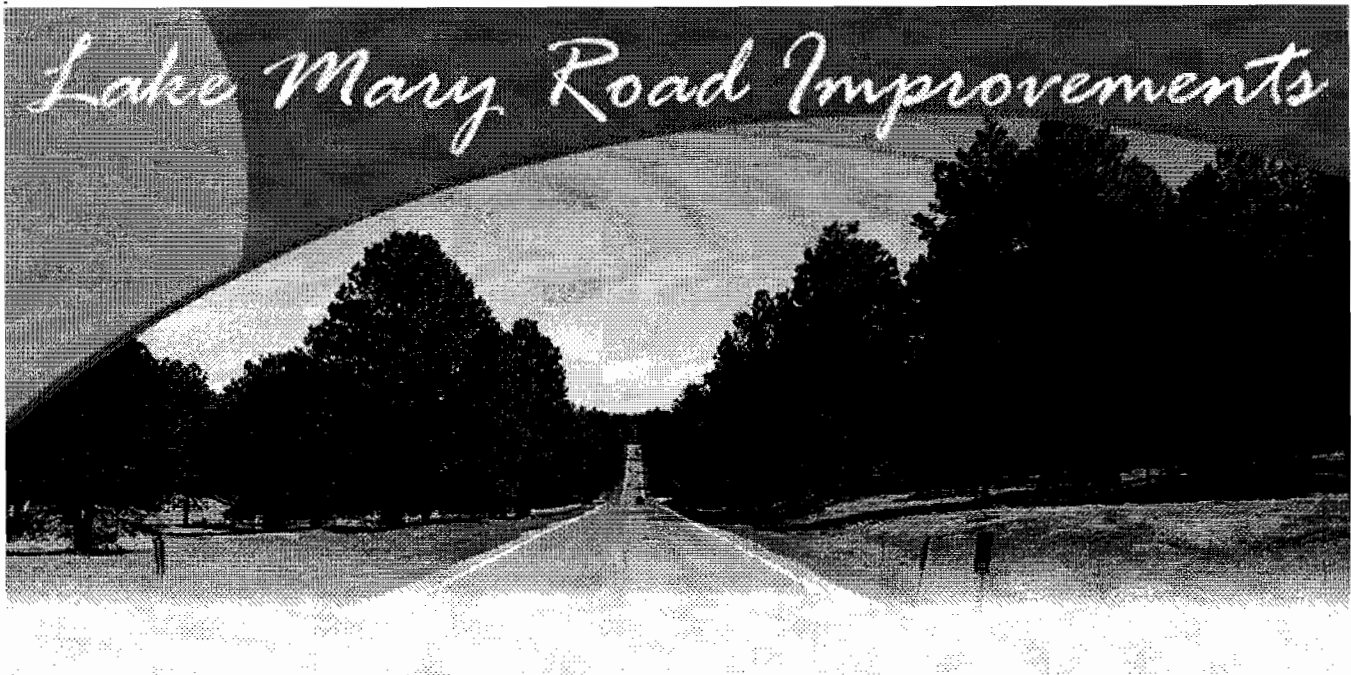

### **ROADWAY WIDENING CONTINUES**

### **VALVE REPLACEMENT WILL REQUIRE WATER SHUT OFF**

A temporary water shut off will be necessary while crews install a new water valve near the Pine Glade neighborhood. If your home will be affected, a 48-hour notice will be provided. Please be aware of the following impacts:

- **Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup> - 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.**

Affected homeowners will experience an interruption in water service while work is being performed. Please plan ahead according to your water needs.
